

## 2022 Rosé, Los Angeles County

The 2022 Rosé is a blend of 75% Tempranillo, and 25% Grenache Gris that is pure summertime in a bottle. Enjoy this crisp and refreshing wine on a hot sunny day by the pool, at the beach, when dining al fresco, or wherever your warm weather adventures take you.

## **Vintage Notes**

The 2022 vintage, was a continuation of the dry growing season that spanned the pandemic. A dry fall was followed by a dry winter, with light rains at the top of spring. Yields were low across LA County, and while fruit was not abundant, the resulting wines are focused and concentrated.

# **Winegrowing & Production Notes**

The latest version of our Rosé is 75% Tempranillo from the Alonso Family Vineyard, with 25% Grenache Gris from Paso Robles. The grapes were picked by hand, with dry ice layered into the bins to preserve the wine's natural freshness, before they were whole cluster pressed and settled into a temperature controlled steel tank. A cool and slow fermentation was followed by 7 months of aging, also in steel.

### **Tasting Notes**

The nose reveals bright aromas of fresh red berries, stone fruit, and hints of rose petals and blooming peonies. The palate greets you with a vibrant burst of flavors. Ripe strawberries and juicy raspberries meld with hint of earth, and a touch of elegance and silky acidity. Citrus zest and apricot peel linger on the clean, crisp finish.
